




Use Ethernet to revolutionize onsite

Until now, it hasn't been easy to connect devices with only an RS-232C port to Ethernet networks. The SerialGateBox solves this problem by allowing devices with RS-232C interfaces, such as PLCs, to connect to Ethernet. Even existing serial devices can perform communications via Ethernet, and information can be transmitted directly to computers in host computer systems.



Note: It may not be possible to connect certain serial devices to the host computer system using the SerialGateBox (Refer to the restrictions described at the end of this document.)



System Configuration

RS-232C communications can be achieved by installing the setup software provided (Virtual COM Software and SGB Remote Setup) on a computer, and specifying a virtual COM port (32 max.) in the computer. Communications are possible with the communications devices connected to the SerialGateBox without


● Connection to RS-232C Communications Devices



making any changes to application software running on the computer that uses the COM port.

With the configuration shown below, several RS-422A/485 communications devices can be connected.

Simply install the set up software on a computer and it's ready to use.



How do I use the SerialGateBox?



Install SGB Remote Setup and Virtual COM Software on a computer and register a COM port. (Set a COM port number in the range 3 to 98 and set the SerialGateBox's IP address.) If CX-Programmer is used, select SYSMAC WAY (Host Link) as the network type and specify the COM port registered in the way described above.

Note: Peripheral bus connection cannot be selected.




How well does the SerialGateBox cope with FA environments?



The SerialGateBox runs on a 24-VDC power supply, has an ambient operating temperature range of 0 to 55 C, and can be mounted using screws or DIN track. This means that no special consideration is required for use in standard FA environments.

 - 1) Searching for SerialGateBoxes operating in the network.
 - 2) Obtaining the current settings for SerialGateBoxes.

 3) Setting parameters for SerialGateBoxes or specified devices.

 4) Initializing SerialGateBoxes.

 - 5) Downloading application programs to SerialGateBoxes.
- Note 2: The number of virtual COM ports that can be registered with the Virtual COM Software is limited to 32. There is no restriction, however, on the number of SerialGateBoxes in the Ethernet network. (Each SerialGateBox must have a unique IP address.)

Be sure to familiarize yourself with the restrictions given below before using the products in actual operation.

Virtual COM Software Provided with the Seria IGateBox (RemoteCOM Client/ Driver Software)

- 1) Detection of break signals is not supported. Operation is not possible for
- applications requiring break signal detection.

 2) Communications parameters that are not supported by the SerialGateBox cannot be used. Details on communications parameters that are supported by the SerialGateBox are given in the Operation Manual. Consult your OMRON representative for details on the Instruction Sheet.
- 3) Delays may occur when data and control signals are input and output via LAN.
- Take these time delays into consideration when designing the system.

 4) With Win16API applications that perform processing with callback routine, the timing for the COM port driver is different from the call timing and so operation may be extremely slow or incorrect operation may occur.
- 5) Communications from the SerialGateBox's RS-232C device side (e.g., unsolicited communications executed from the PLC's ladder program) are not possible.

At present, operation has been confirmed for the following OMRON software products.

- CX-Programmer V3 FinsGateway Version 3 Runtime Edition

The following restrictions apply when using the above software products. Be sure to familiarize yourself with these restrictions before using the software in applications.

- 1) Connection by peripheral bus (ToolBus, ToolBusC, or ToolBusCV) is not possible. Use SYSMAC WAY or SYSWAY.
- Connect the SerialGateBox to a PLC using the same cable that would be used to connect to an IBM PC/AT or compatible computer (D-Sub, 9-pin). When using FinsGateway, however, connect to the PLC using an XW2Z-200S-V/500S-V Connecting Cable.
- 3) There may be occasions where connection is not possible due to network
- 4) The built-in RS-232C port in C20H/C28H/C40H/C60H PLCs cannot be used.
